<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 10-minute introductory session (Creating rapport with students). - Information session on HIV (25 minutes) - Ask students to form groups of 3. - In each group ask Students to pick a couple of sticky notes and write down anything they know about HIV/AIDS ranging from modes of transmission, prevention, treatment, etc., - Let each group pin their sticky notes around the tents. - Together with the students, move around the room (as in an art exhibition) discussing their various pointers on HIV. 	<p><i>The main focus of this topic is information sharing to demystify myths and misconceptions as well as fight stigma.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Screening and testing for HIV: - Counselling pre and Post testing. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Chats -Markers -Sticky notes.
